Jeff Kimmons, a retired US Army Lieutenant General and career intelligence professional, joined Booz Allen in 2011 after 36 years of Army, Joint, and national intelligence assignments. These included serving as the Senior Intelligence Officer at the Joint Special Operations Command and US Central Command, Commander of Army Intelligence and Security Command (INSCOM), and as the Department of the Army G2. Prior to joining Booz Allen in 2011, Mr. Kimmons served as the Director, Intelligence Staff at the Office of the Director of National Intelligence (ODNI), where he orchestrated national-level intelligence support across the US Intelligence community.

As a Booz Allen Vice President, Mr. Kimmons leads the firm's Army military intelligence business, with a focus on support to Army G2, INSCOM, the Army Intelligence Center of Excellence/Fort Huachuca, the Military Intelligence Reserve Command (MIRC), and Army National Guard G2. He serves as a senior advisor in the areas of all-source intelligence analysis, intelligence/surveillance/reconnaissance (ISR), and special operations intelligence support. He sits on the National Intelligence University Foundation (NIUF) Board of Directors.

He holds a B.A. degree in History from the Citadel, Charleston, SC, and an M.B.A. degree from the University of Oklahoma. He was awarded an honorary Doctorate of Intelligence by the National Defense Intelligence College in 2008.
