

Vice Admiral Thomas R. Wilson, USN (Ret)

Vice Admiral Thomas R. Wilson served in the United States Navy from 1968 until he retired in 2002. A career intelligence officer, Admiral Wilson served as Director, Defense Intelligence Agency from 1999-2002. Other key flag rank assignments included Director for Intelligence, The Joint Staff; Associate Director of Central Intelligence for Military Support, and Director for Intelligence, US Atlantic Command.

Following retirement from the Navy, Admiral Wilson was a senior executive for Alliant Techsystems, Inc. (ATK) - - first as President of ATK Missile Systems Company and then as President of the ATK Precision Systems Group. He has also served or is serving on the Boards of Directors of several companies: Global Defense Systems and Technology (Chairman), Global Integrated Security, Meggitt Defense Systems, Meggit Maryland, and SDL Government.

A native of Ohio, Admiral Wilson is a 1968 graduate of the The Ohio State University, earned a masters degree from Webster University, and was a 1975 distinguished graduate of The Defense Intelligence College (predecessor of the National Intelligence University).
